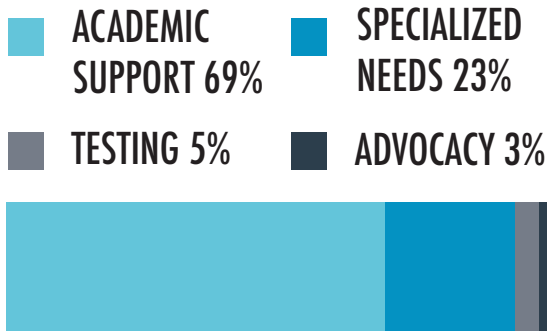

## PROGRAM DISTRIBUTION

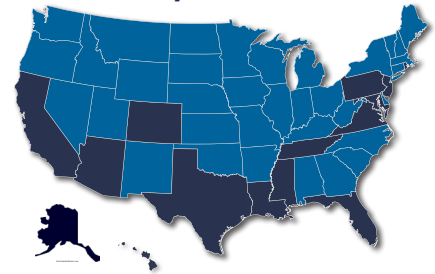

## GRANT CYCLE HIGHLIGHTS

- 255 grants were awarded to benefit NSW families
- 5,761 hours of educational services were awarded
- 100% of participants showed improvement in at least one area
- 70% of grants served children with one or more diagnosed learning disabilities
- 100% of parents reported their child’s academic performance increased
- 99% of parents know more about their child’s educational needs
- 90% of parents state their child has less anxiety about their academic performance

## SERVING STUDENTS WITH THINKING AND LEARNING DIFFERENCES



According to the National Center for Education Statistics, 14% of public school students across the country receive services for one or more learning disabilities under the IDEA Act (nces.ed.gov). Learning disabilities aren’t always easy to identify. SEALKIDS helps identify the root cause of a child’s academic struggles and helps ensure parents have the information and tools they need to support their child.

## THE SEALKIDS SERVICE CYCLE



1. Parents start the process by visiting the SEALKIDS website to request assistance for their child. Parents provide general information about their child's current situation and needs.
2. The request is sent to a SEALKIDS Family Advocate who works directly with families to understand the student's needs and verify eligibility.
3. Family Advocates identify several thoroughly vetted Service Providers that meet the family's unique needs. Families meet with the identified Service Providers and choose the best fit.
4. When the correct Service Provider and service plan have been chosen, students start receiving services. Students follow individualized service plans designed to maximize their success. SEALKIDS pays Service Providers directly for the services.
5. Family Advocates remain available for support and are accountability partners to both Service Providers and families. Families spend less time worrying about academics and have more quality time together!
